Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries in classes with jumps in the trials. Rally Jump Height is required for Advanced and Excellent classes. Transfers (Formerly Move-ups)

• The club will allow transfers – refer to rules and regulations, Chapter 1, General Regulations, Section 16a.

Refunds

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund will be made. The club may cancel the events due to extreme weather conditions.

No entry fee may be returned after entries close, except that of a bitch that comes in season or a dog/bitch for injury after being entered. A refund less a \$5.00 fee per entry to cover expenses will only be issued if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect at least $\frac{1}{2}$ hour prior to the start of classes.

No refunds for overpayment of fees will be made for amounts less than \$5.
