

# **CCRCA National Specialty Junior Handler Entry Reimbursement Form**

The Curly Coated Retriever Club of America (CCRCA) junior entry reimbursement program is offered to all junior handlers ages 9 to 18 years on the day of the event. Juniors entered in conformation (junior showmanship), obedience, rally, agility, working certificate test, and/or upland certificate test at the CCRCA National Specialty are eligible for one entry reimbursement per event. Entry reimbursement will not be given for multiple classes within an event. The junior must enter the event through the proper entry service and provide proof of each entry with this form to receive reimbursement. Note: The junior must be a junior member of the CCRCA or a child of a CCRCA member and must have an AKC Junior Handler number. The dog must be owned by the junior or an individual within their immediate household.

## **CCRCA National Specialty Junior Handler Entry Reimbursement Program**

### Requirements:

Junior handlers must be at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the event to be eligible for entry reimbursement for one class per event at the CCRCA National Specialty. The list of events includes conformation (junior showmanship entry only), obedience, rally, agility, working certificate test, and upland working certificate test, and only on those days that are included in CCRCA National Specialty Versatility Award calculations. Events such as supported entries, all-breed shows, and other events corresponding with the National Specialty event would also not be reimbursed. Only the entry fee will be reimbursed. Reimbursement will not cover taxes or processing fees. Juniors will not be reimbursed if absent from an event or class.

The junior handler must be a junior member of CCRCA or a child of a CCRCA member. The dog must be owned by the junior or an individual within their immediate household. The junior must have and enter with an AKC Junior Handler number.

Entry for each event must be done through the proper entry service and not through the CCRCA. Proof of each entry and the reimbursement form must be sent to CCRCA corresponding secretary within 30 days of the event. Reimbursement will be approved by the CCRCA Board of Directors and issued by the CCRCA Treasurer.
