Versatility Challenge:

Enter and earn a ribbon in a Field event, a Conformation event and also a Performance event to complete the Challenge. We will no longer be doing two levels or a point system.

Rosettes will be awarded in person on the 9th at the Banquet. Rosettes can be mailed at the expense of the qualifier.

A summary of the dogs achievements and a photo of the dog with the ribbon will be published in the Commentator. Please take a photo of your dog with the ribbon and e-mail it to Aubrey.

Other Details:

Eligible Conformation Entries

-Any Regular, Non Regular or Sweepstakes Class placement counts.

If you have a Spayed/Neutered curly or a curly with a disqualifying fault, you can still enter the Versatility Class. This class is made specifically for dogs that do not fit in any of the other classes.

Entries in the Versatility Class are NOT eligible for Best of Breed or any Champion or Grand Champion points. You do not need to be entered in the Versatility class while attempting the versatility challenge.

-Brace counts for both curlies.

-Brood Bitch and Stud Dog counts only for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, they need to be entered in something else in order to get their Conformation ribbon.

-Making the final cut in the National BOB also counts. This can be confusing as each judge does things differently, so it really depends on the day, what happens.

Performance Details

-The Agility trial lasts several days. But only the Qualifying scores on October 4th will count.

-Only Qualifying scores on October 8th will count for Obedience and Rally.
